Day 1 Departing your local departure point we travel to North Wales and to the Royal Victoria Hotel in Llanberis, our base for the next 4 nights with dinner, bed and breakfast provided.

Day 2 Today we enjoy a ride on the Welsh Highland Railway, the UK's longest heritage railway which runs for 25 miles from Caernarfon, past the foot of Snowdon and the picture postcard village of Beddgelert, through the stunning Aberglaslyn Pass and on to Porthmadog. We re-join our coach here and travel to the nearby fascinating village of Portmeirion, exploring the lovely gardens, picturesque village and shops.

Day 3 Today, we take a lovely scenic drive to the pretty village of Betws-y-Coed before continuing through the Conway Valley to the "Queen of Welsh resorts", Llandudno. Here we spend time enjoying its beautiful Victorian architecture, Edwardian elegance, shops and attractions. You may wish to enjoy a ride to the top of the Great Orme on the beautifully restored tram which climbs to 1500m with outstanding views across Llandudno Bay, Anglesey and the Peaks of Snowdonia.

Day 4 This morning we travel over the Menai Bridge to the Isle of Anglesey and visit one of North Wales' best kept secrets, the hidden world of Plas Cadnant Gardens. We enjoy exploring the stunning gardens before we travel to nearby Beaumaris with its medieval castle, lovely beach and Victorian pier.

Day 5 After breakfast today we return home with suitable comfort stops En-route.
