Itinerary*

Day 1 Departing our local area we travel north to Scotland and take the ferry from Wemyss Bay across the Firth of Clyde to Rothesay on the Isle of Bute. Here we have 4 night's dinner, bed & breakfast at the Glenburn Hotel with live entertainment each night.

Day 2 After a leisurely breakfast we make the short journey to Mount Stuart House where we have arranged for a guided tour. Built in the flamboyant Gothic Revival style its main features include the colonnaded Marble Hall at the centre of the main block and the Marble Chapel which has an elaborate spired tower.

Day 3 Today we take the ferry from Rhubodach to Colintrave and head through Glendaruel as we travel north around Loch Fyne and to the ancestral home of the Dukes of Argyll, Inverary. Here we have free time and you may wish to visit the Inverary Jail which is now a living museum or the tea rooms of the local woollen mill.

Day 4 A free day today in which to explore Rothesay. Wander the Victorian frontage overlooking Rothesay Bay or head to the ruins of the 13th century Rothesay Castle and marvel at the Stewart Kings display in the restored great hall gatehouse.

Day 5 After breakfast today we return home to the North East with suitable comfort stops En-route.
