## Itinerary\*

**Day 1** Departing your local departure point we travel to Stratford upon Avon, our base for the next 4 nights with dinner, bed and breakfast provided.

**Day 2** After a leisurely breakfast we are joined by a local guide for a coach tour of Stratford upon Avon taking in the sights of William Shakespeare's birthplace and a drive out to Anne Hathaway's Cottage. After the day is free to explore the town and maybe take a cruise on the water.

**Day 3** Today we travel into Oxfordshire with a visit to the birthplace and ancestral home of Sir Winston Churchill, Blenheim Palace. A UNESCO world heritage site with over 300 years of history, it is one of England's largest houses and a stunning example of architecture sitting in an English Landscape Garden designed by Capability Brown.

**Day 4** After breakfast today we make the short journey to visit one of Warwickshire's finest properties, Charlecote Park. Here we hear the colourful stories of how the Lucy family shaped Charlecote through the ages into what you see today. Legend has it that William Shakespeare was caught poaching deer here and hauled before the local magistrate, Sir Thomas Lucy.

**Day 5** After breakfast today we return home with suitable comfort stops En-route.
