

# The Magical Isle of Man

Measuring approximately 33 miles long and 13 miles wide, you will be surprised how easy it is to explore the Isle of Man. This unique island has it all with its fascinating history, historic railways, relaxed pace and splendid scenery.

## Itinerary\*

**Day 1** Departing your local pick up point today we head to Heysham to board our ferry to Douglas and the Empress Hotel, our base for the next 4 nights where we have dinner, bed and full cooked breakfast provided.

**Day 2** After breakfast we are joined by our local guide for today's excursion to the North of the island. We start off by joining the Manx Electric Railway along the coast from Douglas to Laxey where we hop on board the Snaefell Mountain Railway to the highest point of the island. When we return to Laxey we have opportunity to see the famous Laxey Wheel before joining the coach to Ramsey. Here we have free time and later return to Douglas by coach over the Isle of Man TT mountain course.

**Day 3** Today we visit the Calf Sound overlooking the Calf of Man before visiting the former Capital of the island, Castletown. Here we have arranged a visit to the Old House of Keys which has been restored to its appearance in 1866 and provides visitors with an insight into the political life and times of the Island.

**Day 4** This morning we visit Peel on the west side of the island. This charming seaside town and fishing port is a popular destination for both residents and tourists alike and is home to the Manx kipper industry.

In the afternoon we have free time in which to explore Douglas.

**Day 5** Today we say goodbye to the island and join the ferry for the return crossing to Heysham and back to our original departure points with suitable comfort stops en route.
