## Chester & Scenic North Wales



The ancient city of Chester is a truly breath-taking experience, with the most complete city walls made of local red sandstone, the oldest racecourse, and the largest Roman Amphitheatre in Britain plus a 1000-year-old Cathedral. In the old city, the Rows are a shopping district distinguished by two - level covered arcades and Tudor-style half-timber buildings.

## Itinerary\*

**Day 1** Departing your local departure point we travel to Chester and The Queen Hotel. The hotel is situated in the heart of the City and only a short walk from the Cathedral and shops and is our base for the next 4 nights with dinner, bed and full cooked breakfast.

**Day 2** After breakfast today we join the coach for a Guided City coach tour of Chester and the surrounding area taking in the Duke of Westminster's Estate and the village of Eccleston. After, the day is free to explore this fine city.

**Day 3** We depart the hotel for a scenic drive along the coast through Colwyn Bay, Rhos-on-Sea, Penrhyn Bay with views of the Little Orme and Great Orme before arriving in Llandudno for free time.

Our return journey takes us inland to St.Asaph, where we have a break prior to returning to the hotel.

**Day 4** Today we travel to Llangollen where we have free time. After, we journey over the famous horse-shoe pass to Ruthin, a beautiful Welsh town, continuing our journey over the Clwydian Range of Hills to the hotel.

**Day 5** After a leisurely breakfast today we depart Chester with suitable comfort stops en-route to our original departure points.
