

Dramatic Donegal & A Delve into Derry

We explore another part of the Wild Atlantic Way on this tour heading to the most north westerly point of Ireland and while there we delve into the only complete walled city of Derry, Northern Ireland.

Itinerary*

Day 1 Departing our local area we travel to Cairnryan for our ferry to Belfast. Here we head through Northern Ireland and to the North west of Ireland to the excellent 4 star Redcastle Hotel located on the Inishowen peninsula for 4 nights with dinner bed & full Irish breakfast provided.

Day 2 Today is all about the scenery, as we take a drive around the Inishowen Peninsula. It marks the start of the mighty Wild Atlantic Way and is Ireland's largest peninsula. We enjoy a stop at the most northerly point, Malin Head. In the afternoon we visit the Doagh Famine Village where we have a guided tour, tea/coffee & a scone plus a sample of Poitin, Irish whiskey.

Day 3 Today, we make our way to the spectacular Glenveagh National Park. We visit the award-winning Visitor Centre and enjoy a self-guided tour of the beautiful Glenveagh Castle. After, we return to our hotel, giving us plenty of time to make the most of our wonderful base and its excellent leisure facilities on offer to us.

Day 4 After breakfast today, we head into Northern Ireland and to Derry where we have a guided tour of the city with its 400yr old walls, Guildhall & the Peace Bridge.

Day 5 After breakfast we return home via the Belfast to Cairnryan ferry with suitable stops en-route.
