Itinerarv*

Day 1 Departing our local area we travel to Hull and allow free time in this recent city of culture before boarding the P&O overnight ferry to Rotterdam with dinner, bed & breakfast provided. Sit back, relax and enjoy the excellent entertainment on board as we set sail for the continent.

Day 2 After breakfast on board the ferry we travel through Holland into Germany and onto our overnight hotel in Stuttgart, the Rilano Hotel, with dinner, bed & breakfast.

Day 3 We travel south today through the spectacular scenery of Bavaria and the Austrian Tyrol as we cross the Alps into Italy. Arriving at our mainstay hotel, the 4-star Hotel Sole, situated in the heart of Riva del Garda on the shores of the Lake. This is our base for the next 6 nights with dinner, bed & breakfast and all excursions included.

Day 4 Today is a free day at leisure in which to relax and explore your new surroundings. Riva Del Garda is an

excellent base at the Northern tip of Lake Garda. The old town has many shops and cafes with plenty to explore and there is a long beachside promenade to stroll.

Day 5 Departing after breakfast we head to the world-famous city of Verona, the setting of a number of Shakespeare's plays. Verona is famed for its architecture, including the 1st century Roman amphitheatre, the venue for the city's annual summer opera festival. Piazza Bra is lined with numerous cafés and restaurants and you may even wish to visit the Casa di Giulietta to re-enact the famous balcony scene from Romeo & Juliet.

Day 6 We have included a lake cruise today in order to visit the pretty town of Limone on the western shore of Lake Garda, before then, heading to Malcesine on the eastern shore situated at the foot of Monte Baldo with its pretty cobbled lanes, restaurants and Scaliger Castle.

Day 7 Today we enjoy a lakeside tour along the eastern shore of Lake Garda passing through pretty towns and villages along the way as we head to Garda Town on market day with its wonderful promenade. This afternoon we visit the peninsula of Sirmione, situated at the foot of the lake with its well-preserved Scaliger Castle.

Day 8 Our final day in resort is a free day to soak up the atmosphere and charms of Riva del Garda.

Day 9 After breakfast today we bid a fond farewell to Italy as we travel over the Brenner Pass into Austria before travelling over the Fern Pass heading for our overnight stop in Stuttgart, Germany, with dinner, bed and breakfast provided.

Day 10 Today we depart and travel to Rotterdam in order to board our overnight ferry back to Hull with dinner, bed, breakfast and a range of entertainment provided.

Day 11 After breakfast on board the ship we depart and rejoin our coach for the short journey back home from Hull with a suitable comfort stop provided en-route.
