The Petwood Hotel, Woodall Spa, enjoys a timelessly elegant setting and a unique heritage. Once home to 617 Squadron, The Dambusters, it is surrounded by acres of beautifully landscaped gardens and woodland and is steeped in British history.

Day 1 Departing our local area, we travel to Woodhall Spa and the Petwood Hotel. This is our base for the next 4 nights with dinner, bed & breakfast provided.

Day 2 We start our day with a guided tour of the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight at RAF Coningsby. The RAF BBMF operates a total of 12 airworthy historic aircraft: An Avro Lancaster, a Douglas C-47 Dakota, six Supermarine Spitfires, two Hawker Hurricanes and two de Havilland Chipmunks, this living and breathing tribute to 'The Many'

and 'The Few' is not to be missed. After our guided tour we then make the short journey to the Lincolnshire Aviation Heritage Centre where we have free time to explore the exhibition, displays, artifacts and cafe.

Day 3 The morning is free in Woodhall to explore this former Edwardian spa town. After lunch we visit the historic Kinema in the Woods where we are treated to a mystery viewing. Housed in a former cricket pavilion, it opened in 1922 as one of the first cinemas in Britain. It is the last cinema in the country to use back projection.

Day 4 Today we visit the Cathedral City of Lincoln, steeped in history, Lincoln offers a range of shopping facilities, a stunning castle which houses one of the four surviving copies of the Magna Carta and its historic cathedral is worth a visit too.
