## Itinerary\*

**Day 1** Departing our local area, we travel south with suitable comfort breaks en-route to the Lanhydrock Hotel and Golf Club. Our base for the next 4 nights.

**Day 2** After a leisurely start we enjoy our included visit to the world-famous Eden Project and its giant covered biomes which house a wealth of Rainforest and Mediterranean indigenous plant species. Discover more in the botanical gardens with plants from the British Isles.

**Day 3** Today we travel on the Bodmin Railway for a 2-hour steam journey through scenic Cornish countryside. In the afternoon we travel to the north coast to visit Cornwall's foodie Capital, Padstow. Made famous by Rick Stein, Padstow is not all about the great food, it's also a historic fishing port with a maze of picturesque narrow streets of stone, painted and slate cottages, a pretty working harbour located at the mouth of the River Camel.

**Day 4** After breakfast today, we head for the South Coast and visit Mevagissey with its picture postcard style, pubs, cafes, galleries and shops that cluster around the harbour walls and line the pretty streets. After we head for Fowey, with its narrow streets where medieval and Georgian buildings cast shadows over each other and a vibrant maritime history comes to life. Small, independent shops selling unusual gifts, art, clothing and books vie with cafes and pubs for your attention, whilst small alleys offer glimpses of the river every now and again.

**Day 5** After breakfast we return home with suitable stops en-route.
