



### **Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> March – Halifax & The Piece Hall - £56pp – Red Route**

One of Britain's most remarkable heritage sites, originally built in 1779 as a cloth hall for handwoven textiles, enjoy our hour-long tour of the Piece Hall, then take time to explore the grounds, relax and enjoy the atmosphere or explore the town of Halifax. *Includes a 3-course meal on our return journey.*

### **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> April – Beamish - £36pp – Blue Route**

Go back in time to experience life in the North East of England during the 1820s, 1900s, and 1940s. Explore historic towns, working farms, and vintage transport, bringing the region's rich heritage vividly to life.

### **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> April – The Alnwick Garden - £42pp – Blue Route**

Experience the enchantment of the gardens in spring! Stroll beneath one of the largest collections of Taihaku cherry blossom trees in the world, a breathtaking sight creating a magical canopy above. This trip includes access to Auckland Palace, Faith Museum & Gardens.

### **Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> August – Kynren - £55pp – Purple Route**

### Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September – Lake District – Transport Trio Tour - £59pp – Blue Route

### Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> October – Nissan Factory Tour - £54pp – Blue Route
